# RULES OF PLAY

1. The Format will be Captains Choice.
2. Men will tee off from the white tees unless you are 62 yrs of age and older and you can tee off from the gold tees. Women will tee off from the red tees.
3. Each player may place the ball to be hit within one club length of the chosen ball but no closer to the hole. However, if the chosen ball in a hazard, or in the rough, each of the team shots must be taken from the hazard or the rough.
4. The only score to be reported on the scorecard is the number of strokes required for the team to complete the hole.
5. The highest score that can be recorded in any hole is a bogey. As soon as the team reaches par +1, pick up the ball and move to the next hole. No additional shots are to be taken and this will assist with the pace of play.
6. The highest score that can be recorded is a 90.
7. No handicaps will be used for this tournament.
8. Teams will be flighted after the gross scores are submitted and verified. There will be 2 flights: the lowest scoring groups will be in the 1st flight, the highest scoring groups will be in the 2nd flight.
9. Ties will be broken by matching cards beginning with the lowest handicapped hole and proceeding in order until one team has a lower score than the other.
10. The first team in each flight will win a prize.
11. Players will also receive a prize for closest to the pin on a designated Par 3 and the longest drives on a designated Par 5, men's and womans. Ball must be in the Fairway to count and not a mulligan or red bomb.

# DID YOU KNOW?

## HOW HAVE THE FUNDS FROM THE 2019 KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT BEEN USED?

- ❖ Our Seminarian's were supported with over \$1,600 to purchase dormitory, study and personal goods that were needed during their Seminarian Studies.
- ❖ St Catherine of Siena School received \$5,000 to support their mission to provide a quality Catholic Education to our children.
- ❖ Supported weekly Food Ministries, Brown Bag and Operations Harvest, with financial support and volunteer hours to provide weekly groceries to 25 families every week... a total of 1,300 visits. Accomplished through generous donations from Lowes Food, Tri-Area Ministries and many Parishioners and friends in the Community.
- ❖ Coordinated 5 weeks of Food Drives and over \$7,000 in donations from Parishioners and others to support our most vulnerable seniors during the early days of COVID. This was achieved through a partnership with Meals on Wheels and Resources for Seniors using the Wake Forest Senior Center.
